**DISCLAIMER: FAKE ADMISSION LETTERS IN CIRCULATION**

The attention of the authorities of the University of Energy and Natural Resources (UENR), Sunyani has been drawn to fake admission letters in circulation purportedly signed by the Senior Assistant Registrar, Academics and Students Affairs Directorate and requesting payment of fees via mobile money.

The fake letters contain an offer of admission into certain programmes (such as BSc Chemical Engineering, which programme is not ran by the University) and a mobile number (+233551197794) by which fees are supposedly to be paid into.

**THE UNIVERSITY HEREBY WARNS** the general public and prospective students to be wary of such admission letters from fraudsters and scammers because **the University does not run Regular Online programmes** and **also does not in any way receive fees via mobile money except through the banks.**

The general public is further informed that its form and content did not emanate from authorities of the University of Energy and Natural Resources.

The University website [www.uenr.edu.gh](http://www.uenr.edu.gh) and official social media platforms are the only authentic online sources of information on admissions. All programmes ran by the University are on the University's official website. The official WhatsApp lines of the University are 0205475443/0553581475/0552590370.

4. The University has limited on-campus accommodation for all freshmen. Due to this, you are going to do everything online. Base on on your studies, you are an online regular applicant.
5. Should the information you have provided be found to be false or should you be found to be deficient in the entry requirements at any time in the course of your study, you will be dismissed from the university or your certificate will be revoked in the case where you have graduated.
6. The University expects all students to be medically fit throughout their studies. You will be required to undergo a medical examination to be conducted by the University medical staff. You will be required to bring a **chest X-ray** at your own cost for examination.
